aquarium net to transfer the tadpoles from habitat to holding pail Tadpoles can tolerate a wide range of temperatures but not a sudden temperature change Never transfer tadpoles to water that differs in temperature by more than 1 to 15° C (2 to 3° F) For maximum growth, put no more than 30 small tadpoles in every 4 liters (1 gallon) of water
